<u>Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor, General Dentist, Restorative Clinical Sciences, position # 38690</u> The University of Missouri-Kansas City School of Dentistry is seeking a general dentist faculty member to fill a position in the Restorative Clinical Sciences department. The position is a 100% benefit eligible, full time, non-tenure track position at the rank of Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor. The faculty member will provide clinical instruction and oversight for pre-doctoral dental students. This includes instruction and evaluation of students in diagnosis, treatment planning, restorative dentistry, removable, fixed, and implant prosthodontics, endodontics, and non-surgical periodontics; experience in pediatric dentistry is a plus. The faculty member is expected to provide didactic and preclinical lab instruction, as assigned. A DDS/DMD or equivalent is required. Eligibility for Missouri licensure and Advanced Education in General Dentistry/General Practice Residency training or equivalent is preferred. Qualified candidates may be eligible to participate in faculty practice one day per week.

Assistant/Associate Professor-Tenure track, Oral Pathology, Radiology, & Medicine, position # 38794

UMKC is seeking applications for a full-time faculty in the Section of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology of the Department of Oral Pathology, Radiology and Medicine. Qualified candidates should be Board certified or eligible in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology and have a commitment to teaching, clinical dentistry and service. Specific responsibilities include pre-and post doctoral dental and dental hygiene classroom and clinical teaching. Academic rank, tenure status and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Qualified candidates may be eligible to participate in faculty practice one day per week. For non US DDS candidates with US training and board eligibility in oral and maxillofacial radiology, an international faculty DDS program is available after an initial period of service. Interviews of qualified candidates will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled. Salary and rank will be commensurate with experience. Eligibility for a Missouri dental licensure, Missouri Teaching license, or Missouri Dental Faculty permit is required.
