Did you know you need to have an eRA Commons ID to submit an NIH grant?

• What is eRA Commons?

eRA Commons (<u>https://public.era.nih.gov/commons/</u>) is an online interface where grant applicants, grantees and federal staff at NIH and grantor agencies can access and share administrative information relating to research grants.

• A Commons ID is encouraged, but currently optional, for all other project personnel. A general Commons Role of Project Personnel is available for those not assigned other Commons Roles.

What are the features?

eRA Commons users, based on their role, can conduct a variety of business in Commons, including:

- Track the status of their grant applications through the submission process, view errors and/or warnings and check the assembled grant image.
- View <u>summary statements</u> and <u>score</u> letters following the initial review of their applications.
- View <u>notice of award</u> and other key documents.
- Submit <u>Just-in-Time</u> information (signing officials only) requested by the grantor agency prior to a final award decision.
- o Submit an annual progress report electronically using the <u>Research Performance Progress Report (RPPR)</u>.
- Submit the required documentation, including the Financial Status Report/Federal Financial Report, Final Research Performance Progress Report, and Final Invention Statement to close out the grant.
- Submit Prior Approval requests, including no-cost extensions, carryover, change of PD/PI, and withdrawal of an application.

Who needs an eRA Commons Account for Application Submission?

- Project Director/Principal Investigator (PD/PI) and any multiple-PD/PIs
- Sponsor on a fellowship application
- Component leads on a multi-project application
- Candidates for diversity supplement support
- Primary mentor identified on individual mentored career development applications

Who needs an eRA Commons Account for Progress Reporting?

- Project Director/Principal Investigator (PD/PI) and any multiple-PD/PIs
- o Undergraduate
- o Graduate Student
- o Postdoctoral
