

Joint Certificate in Dental Informatics

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants for the Dental Informatics Program are considered based on a [completed application](#) and the following criteria:

- Baccalaureate degree or higher;
- Grade-point average of 3.0 or higher;
- Dentistry and/or informatics work experience and training;
- One letter of reference;
- Resume and/or curriculum vitae;
- Personal interview (when requested by the department);
- TOEFL for applicants who are nationals of countries where English is not the primary language
- Other specific information may be requested directly by the program director.

Applications are accepted from **December 1st** to **February 28th** for the following Fall semester.

Applicants who are already UTSD students should complete the residency application, write a personal statement about why they want to do the program, and interview with the committee.
