



## **Joint Certificate in Dental Informatics**

## **HOW TO APPLY**

Applicants for the Dental Informatics Program are considered based on a <u>completed application</u> and the following criteria:

- · Baccalaureate degree or higher;
- Grade-point average of 3.0 or higher;
- Dentistry and/or informatics work experience and training;
- One letter of reference;
- Resume and/or curriculum vitae;
- Personal interview (when requested by the department);
- TOEFL for applicants who are nationals of countries where English is not the primary language
- Other specific information may be requested directly by the program director.

Applications are accepted from December 1st to February 28th for the following Fall semester.

Applicants who are already UTSD students should complete the residency application, write a personal statement about why they want to do the program, and interview with the committee.
